ABOUT THE VENUES

NEWTOWN

Dickson Street Space, 35-39 Dickson Street (off King Street).

Come through the side gates to the rear of the building.

Toilets are not accessible by wheelchair.

Transport: Closest train station is St Peters. Buses 308, 370 and 422 stop on King Street nr Dickson; 352 stops on Alice nr Pearl. Bike parking at the back door. Car parks are usually easy to find on the street.

ERSKINEVILLE

Erskineville Town Hall, 104 Erskineville Road.

The venue is fully accessible by wheelchair.

Transport: Closest train station is Erskineville. Bus 355 stops on Erskineville Road nr the Town Hall. Bike parking inside. Car parks are difficult to find.
